WHEREAS: A REPLICA OF THE AMERICAN WHITE HOUSE WILL BE DISPLAYED IN MINNESOTA BETWEEN JULY 14 AND JULY 21, 1981; AND

WHEREAS: Rosedale Shopping Center has been chosen as the place to display this work of art; during this single Minnesota showing; and

WHEREAS: This twenty-year project was created by John and Jan Zweifel of Orlando, Florida; and

WHEREAS: THE STRUCTURE IS AN EXACT ONE-INCH TO ONE-FOOT SCALE REPLICA OF THE WHITE HOUSE AS IT STOOD ON JULY 4, 1976, AND IS THE ONLY ONE OF ITS KIND IN THE WORLD; AND

WHEREAS: This White House Replica is a gift from its creators to the American people, with the hope that it will encourage a better understanding of the dramatic role the White House has played in the American story;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JULY 14 THROUGH 21, 1981 TO BE

WHITE HOUSE DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
