



Proclamation

WHEREAS: IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA ARE PROVIDED WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN BASIC SKILLS NECESSARY FOR A PRODUCTIVE AND SATISFYING LIFE; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA LITERACY COUNCIL IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION ENGAGED IN TRAINING VOLUNTEERS TO TUTOR IN BASIC READING AND WRITING; AND

WHEREAS: WE JOIN WITH OTHER NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL LITERACY GROUPS IN ENCOURAGING THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA TO INVOLVE THEMSELVES IN THIS IMPORTANT EFFORT AS TUTORS, LEARNERS, LEADERS OR DONORS; AND

WHEREAS: THE UNITED NATIONS HAS DECLARED SEPTEMBER 8, 1981 TO BE OBSERVED THROUGHOUT THE WORLD AS INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 1981 TO BE

INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY

AND THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 1981 TO BE

INTERNATIONAL LITERACY MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
