
ORDINANCE NO. 57

An ordinance relating to intoxicating liquor; hours for Sunday sale as required by Minn. Law.

The Metropolitan Airports Commission, sometimes known as the Minneapolis-Saint Paul Metropolitan Airports Commission, does ordain:

Section 1. - Any person, partnership or corporation licensed by the Metropolitan Airports Commission to sell intoxicating liquor on Sundays may do so between hours of 10:00 o'clock a.m. and 12:00 o'clock midnite on Sundays in conjunction with the serving of food, provided that the licensee establishment is in conformance with the Minnesota Clean Indoor Air Act.

Section 2. - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of August 1, 1981.

(5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Minneapolis in the County of Hennepin, and has its known office of issue in the City of Minneapolis in said county, established and opened during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its emand maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its em-ploy and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed.
