WHEREAS: COMPAS HAS BROUGHT COLOR INTO PEOPLE'S LIVES AND NEIGHBORHOODS, AND HAS RECEIVED NATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR INNOVATIVE ARTS PROGRAMMING; AND

WHEREAS: STUDENTS THROUGHOUT MINNESOTA HAVE GROWN THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN SUCH EXCELLENT PROGRAMS AS WRITERS-IN-THE-SCHOOLS; AND

WHEREAS: COMPAS PROGRAMS HAVE TOUCHED THE LIVES OF SENIOR CITIZENS, THE HANDICAPPED AND THE TRADITIONALLY UNDERSERVED, THROUGH ITS CLASSES AND FESTIVALS; AND

WHEREAS: ARTISTS WORKING IN VARIOUS MEDIUMS HAVE FOUND EMPLOYMENT AND ENCOURAGEMENT IN COMPAS; AND

WHEREAS: THE COMMITMENT OF COMPAS TO BRING ARTS EXPERIENCES INTO NEIGHBORHOODS HAS CONTRIBUTED GREATLY TO THE QUALITY OF LIFE WE ENJOY IN MINNESOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SEPTEMBER 23, 1981 TO BE

COMPAS DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SEVENTH DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
