WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota recognize the humanitarian work being done by Courage Center, and the many hours of hard work and dedication put forth by high school marching bands; and

WHEREAS: In the State of Minnesota, as well as across the country, there has been a renewed interest and a sincere dedication to the development, improvement and preservation of quality music programs in high schools; and

WHEREAS: This dedication and hard work by high school bands has been strengthened and supported by the creation of MUSIC BOWL II. A unique high school marching band contest, which will be held in Parade Stadium on Sunday, October 11, 1981, for benefit of the Courage Center and the participating high school bands from throughout Minnesota and surrounding states;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA,
DO HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 11, 1981 TO BE

MUSIC BOWL II DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I CALL UPON CITIZENS TO RECOGNIZE THE NEED TO SUPPORT COURAGE CENTER AND OUR HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BANDS, AND TO BECOME AWARE OF THE ACTIVITIES AND EFFORTS OF HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BANDS TO PROTECT THE MARCHING BAND HERITAGE FOR PRESENT AND FUTURE GENERATIONS.
