



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MAINTAINING THE HEALTH OF THE MINNESOTA WORKER IS A VITAL FUNCTION OF THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE; AND

WHEREAS: THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE IS THE PRIMARY MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL IN THE MAJORITY OF WORK SITES; AND

WHEREAS: THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE IS CONTINUOUSLY UPDATING AND EXPANDING HIS OR HER SKILLS BY ATTENDING CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSES WAS ORGANIZED FOURTEEN YEARS AGO WITH THIRTY MEMBERS, AND TODAY HAS A MEMBERSHIP OF 231 REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL NURSES; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSES IS SPONSORING THE REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSING SEMINAR IN COOPERATION WITH THE CONTINUING NURSING EDUCATION DEPARTMENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA ON OCTOBER 8 AND 9, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 4 THROUGH 9, 1981 TO BE
