PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, E. L. Sylvester, President of the Plainview State Bank, disappeared on or about March 2, 1925, and his whereabouts since that time have not been known<sup>to</sup> to the public authorities; and

WHEREAS, the said E. L. Sylvester has been indicted on charges of embezzlement and misappropriation of the funds of the said Plainview State Bank, and the ends of justice demand that he be apprehended and tried upon said charges;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State of Minnesota, the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, for the apprehension and return, or for information leading to the apprehension and return of the said E. L. Sylvester.
