Dear Madam Secretary:

Please find <u>enclosed an extract of the minutes of the</u> Board of Managers of the Riley-Purgatory Creek Watershed District for its regularly scheduled meeting of August 5, 1981.

This extract is <u>sent to you for informational purposes</u> inasmuch as it appears from provisons of Chapter 69, Minnesota Session Laws, 1981, that local approval of special laws by this governing body pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 645 is not required. The managers, however, wish to reaffirm actions previously taken in regard to local approval for the initial legislation as well as reaffirming this action pertaining to this corrective legislation.

The Managers do intend to implement provisons of these referenced laws in order to levy for its initial water maintenance and repair fund for purposes of funding during calendar year 1982.

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In reviewing these materials, should you be of the opinion that a certificate of approval of special law by governing body is required, please advise the undersigned as counsel for the Watershed District so that that certificate may be duly executed as the District has authorized its Secretary to do in the event that such certificate is needed. If not, the Managers do intend to consider during September, 1981, at its budget hearings the authorization for levy of up to \$30,000 for this water maintenance and repair fund.

CERTIFIED COPY OF RESOLUTION OF THE RILEY-PURGATORY CREEK WATERSHED DISTRICT ACCEPTING CHAPTER 69, MINNESOTA SESSION LAWS, 1931 AND REAFFIRMING APPROVAL OF ACCEPTANCE OF 1980 LEGISLATION AFFECTING THE DISTRICT

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Manager Cardinal offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by manager Rahr:

WHEREAS, the Riley-Purgatory Creek Watershed District has been organized under Chapter 112 of the Minnesota Statutes with general regulatory power over the water and related land resources within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Riley-Purgatory Creek Watershed District has undertaken improvement projects and cooperative projects with other governmental agencies for the purpose of improving the water courses and water bodies within the District and enhancing recreational areas and wildlife habitats; and

WHEREAS, the 1980 Minnesota Legislature has enacted Chapter 614, Section 86, and Chapter 501; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Managers of the Riley-Purgatory Creek Watershed District has previously formally approved and accepted said laws enacted in the 1980 Minnesota Legislative Session by Board action taken on June 4, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Managers wishes to reaffirm that action previously taken by the Board of Managers in approving and accepting that legislation; and

WHEREAS, the 1981 Minnesota Legislature has corrected certain errors pertaining to this Watershed District in that above-referenced 1980 legislation by enacting Chapter 69, Minnesota Session Laws, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the Board of Managers of the Riley-Purgatory Creek Watershed District does hereby move and accept Chapter 69, Minnesota Session Laws, 1981 as adopted by the 1981 Minnesota Legislature;
- 2. The Board of Managers of the Riley-Purgatory Creek Watershed District does hereby reaffirm its formal action in approving and accepting the 1980 legislation affecting this Watershed District;

3. That although it is not formally required to file with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 645.021, a copy of this resolution, it however shall do so for informational purposes only so as to reaffirm previous findings of this Watershed District in permitting the authorization for a mill levy for funding of the water maintenance and repair fund and authorizing a levy of up to \$30,000 the first year in which this fund is to be established.
