HEREAS: Nineteen Eighty-One marks the centennial of the American Labor Movement; and

HEREAS: Organized labor has always endeavored to maintain and improve good working conditions and wage standards for American workers; and

HEREAS: Labor's distinctive emblems of quality craftsmanship and service are Labels, Shop Cards, Store Cards, and Service Buttons; and

HEREAS: The Union Label and Service Trades Department, AFL-CIO each year sponsors UNION LABEL WEEK to salute these hallmarks that are uniquely American;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 7 through 12, 1981 as

in Minnesota, and have asked Lieutenant Governor Lou Wangberg to prepare this proclamation for my signature and disseminate the same.
