

An Unsurveyed Island located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 65 North, Range 9 West, 4th P.M., lying North 2° East 2000 feet from M.C. No. 3 on Southeast corner of Lot 2 of said Section, containing approximately 0.25 acre.

An Unsurveyed Island located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 65 North, Range 9 West, 4th P.M., lying North 60° West 450 feet from M.C. No. 7 on Southwest corner of Lot 3 of said Section, containing approximately 2.50 acres.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said three Islands should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
