WHEREAS: ACCURATE AND EFFICIENT PRESERVATION OF GOVERNMENT RECORDS AND RECORDS PLAYS A VITAL ROLE IN UNDERSTANDING OUR SOCIETY AND PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE OF OUR STATE AND NATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STATE ARCHIVES AND RECORDS ADMINISTRATORS IS DEDICATED TO PROMOTING AWARENESS AND UNDERSTANDING OF STATE ARCHIVES AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS, AND ENCOURAGING STATE ARCHIVES AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT AGENCIES TO IMPROVE THEIR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA WILL HOST THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STATE ARCHIVES AND RECORDS ADMINISTRATORS ON JULY 30, 1981; AND

WHEREAS: ASSOCIATION MEMBERS REPRESENTING STATE ARCHIVES AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT UNITS FROM MOST STATES AND TERRITORIES WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN THIS IMPORTANT MEETING;
