



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE UNITED STATES, AND THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, HAVE FACED SERIOUS ENERGY SHORTAGES FOR THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS, AND SUCH SHORTAGES ARE LIKELY TO BE A PART OF OUR LIVES IN FUTURE YEARS; AND

WHEREAS: CONSERVATION IS AN EFFECTIVE WAY TO ALLEVIATE ENERGY SHORTAGES BY REDUCING OUR CONSUMPTION OF LIMITED RESOURCES; AND

WHEREAS: FOR THE PAST FIFTY YEARS, THE MINNESOTA JAYCEES HAVE BEEN ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN THE LIVES OF OUR CITIZENS THROUGH COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS; AND

WHEREAS: THE JAYCEES HAVE THIS YEAR JOINED WITH THE MINNESOTA ENERGY AGENCY IN PROMOTING ENERGY CONSERVATION AND AWARENESS IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JULY 1, 1981 TO BE

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIRST DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
