WHEREAS: ONE OF THE MOST TRUSTWORTHY INDICATORS OF THE HEALTH, STRENGTH AND PROGRESS OF A NATION IS THE ATTITUDE IN WHICH THE FAMILY IS HELD; AND

WHEREAS: FAMILY STRENGTH, UNITY AND RESPECT CANNOT BE PURCHASED OR FABRICATED, IT COMES TO US INSTEAD WHEN FAMILIES ARE TOGETHER AND REALIZE THAT THROUGH INTERACTION THEY KNOW LOVE, TRUST AND HOPE; AND

WHEREAS: LIFE IS SPECIAL WHEN WE REALIZE THE WORTH OF THE FAMILY RELATIONSHIP AND ITS IMPORTANCE IN ALL RELATIONSHIPS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 22 THROUGH 28, 1981 TO BE

FAMILY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THIS WEEK WITH APPROPRIATE ACTIONS IN THEIR HOMES AND COMMUNITIES.
