WHEREAS: DURING THE PAST YEAR, PREVENTABLE FIRES HAVE TAKEN 122 LIVES AND II. JURED HUNDREDS IN MINNESOTA; AND

REAS: DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY BY FIRE RESULTED IN AN ANNUAL LOSS OF THAN 75 MILLION DOLLARS, AN UNTOLD NUMBER OF JOBS, AND AN IRREPLACEABLE ALDINT OF PRODUCTION; AND

. LAS: SAFETY OF LIVES AND PROPERTY, AND CONSERVATION OF NATURAL RESOURCES ARE OF PRIMARY IMPORTANCE TO EVERY CITIZEN OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHIRLAS: THE EFFECTIVENESS OF SOUND FIRE PREVENTION PROGRAMS HAS BEEN D MONSTRATED IN COMMUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE LAND;

OM, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA. DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 4 THROUGH 10, 1981 TO BE

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK
