WHEREAS. THE AMERICAN LABOR MOVEMENT CELEBRATES ITS CENTENNIAL IN 1981; AID

WHI REAS: THE FEDERATION OF ORGANIZED TRADES AND LABOR UNIONS WAS CREATED IN 1881 TO UNIFY THE LABOR MOVEMENT AND TO WORK FOR THE EIGHT-HOUR DAM. - CO FILSORY PUBLIC SCHOOL BENCATION, FLIMINATION OF CHILD LABOR, PAYHENT MASES IN CURRENCY, APPRENTICES HIP REGULATION AND REPEAL OF ALL CONSPIRACY 1 % S THAT APPLY TO UNION EFFORTS TO ORGANIZE WORKERS: AND

THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 13 THROUGH 19, 1981 TO BE

LABOR CENTENNIAL WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG PRETARS THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-EIGHTH DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE SINE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD,
