



Proclamation

WHEREAS: OLDER AMERICANS HAVE MUCH TO CONTRIBUTE AND CAN LEAD REWARDING AND SATISFYING LIVES DURING THEIR RETIREMENT YEARS; AND

WHEREAS: FOR TEN YEARS, THE RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (RSVP) HAS OFFERED RETIRED PERSONS AN OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE THEIR COMMUNITIES IN AREAS SUCH AS HEALTH, NUTRITION, EDUCATION AND TRANSPORTATION; AND

WHEREAS: MORE THAN 10,000 MINNESOTANS ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN RSVP; AND

WHEREAS: WITH SOME 300,000 VOLUNTEERS SERVING NATIONWIDE, RSVP IS BY FAR THE LARGEST FEDERAL VOLUNTEER PROGRAM;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 20 THROUGH 26, 1981 TO BE
