WHEREAS: DURING TIME OF WAR, THE PEOPLE OF OUR NATION HAVE MADE TREMENDOUS SACRIFICES TO PROTECT AND DEFEND OUR FREEDOM AND LIBERTY; AND

WHEREAS: THROUGH THEIR SERVICE DURING A MAJOR CONFLICT IN THE HISTORY OF OUR WORLD, AMERICA'S VETERANS OF WORLD WAR I MADE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE QUALITY OF LIFE WE ENJOY TODAY; AND

WHEREAS: VETERANS OF WORLD WAR I CONTINUE TO SERVE THEIR COMMUNITIES, STATES AND NATION WITH THE SAME DEDICATION THEY DEMONSTRATED DURING THEIR ACTIVE MILITARY SERVICE; AND

WHEREAS: THE VETERANS OF WORLD WAR I OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, INC., AND ITS LADIES AUXILIARY, ARE HONORING MINNESOTA BY HOLDING THEIR NATIONAL CONVENTION IN OUR STATE, SEPTEMBER 5 THROUGH 10, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 5 THROUGH 10, 1981 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SEVENTH DAY OF AUGUST IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
