ORDINANCE NO. 81

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the City of Spicer, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Minnesota, to include Certain Lands Not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres.

WHEREAS, a Petition and an Amendment thereto have been filed with the governing body of the City of Spicer, a municipal corporation of the State of Minnesota, by the property owner having the sole interest therein, to have certain real property hereinafter described included in the limits of the City of Spicer; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed to annex by virtue hereto to said City of Spicer, said property all of which property is in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the property to be annexed consists of nine parcels described as follows, to-wit:

Lots 1, 2, and 3, Block 1, Hertel's Addition; also the South Half of Lot 3, all of Lot 4, and all of Lot 5 in Subdivision of Government Lot 3, also known as Peder Pederson's Subdivision of said Government Lot 3, Section 34, Township 121, Range 34, lying easterly of Minnesota Trunk Highway 23, excepting the South 50 feet of said Lot 5; also, that part of Lot 6 of said Subdivision of Government Lot 3, Section 34, Township 121, Range 34, commencing at the Southeast corner of said Lot 6, thence North along the East line of said Lot 6, 25 feet; thence West parallel to the South line of said Lot 6, 125 feet; thence South parallel to the East line of said Lot 6, 25 feet; thence East to the point of beginning.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Spicer hereby determines, ordains, and declares as follows:

I.

That the annexation would be in the best interest of the City of Spicer, Minnesota, and to the best interest of the property affected.

II.

That the property above-described butts on the city limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City Government.

That the property is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Spicer, Minnesota, as effectually as if it has originally been a part hereof.

That this Ordinance shall be filed and shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the filing of a copy of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, New London Town Clerk, Kandiyohi County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of Minnesota, from and after its passage and publication.
