



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE FOUR SEASONS INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION ORIGINATED FROM THE FIRST ARMY COMBAT AIRBORNE UNIT SENT TO SOUTH VIET NAM BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES; AND

WHEREAS: THE FOUR SEASONS INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION ORIGINATED IN MINNEAPOLIS, MINNESOTA, AND EXTENDED STATE-WIDE IN 1968; AND

WHEREAS: THE FOUR SEASONS INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION HAS SUCCESSFULLY PROMOTED GOODWILL THROUGH RECOGNIZING OUTSTANDING LEADERSHIP IN OUR STATE AND NATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE FOUR SEASONS INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION HAS RAISED MONEY FOR EDUCATION, YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS AND COMMUNITY CAUSES; AND

WHEREAS: ON NOVEMBER 11, 1982, THE NATIONAL VIETNAM MEMORIAL WILL BE COMPLETED IN WASHINGTON, D.C., AND AT THAT TIME THE FOUR SEASONS INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION WILL BE DISCONTINUED;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SEPTEMBER 23, 1981 TO BE

DAY OF THE FOUR SEASONS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE HIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
