



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS SUPPORTED AND COMMITTED TO PROVIDE FOR THE FULL PARTICIPATION OF INDIAN TRIBAL AND INDIVIDUALLY OWNED INDIAN ECONOMIC ENTERPRISES IN THE STATE'S PROCUREMENT OF GOODS, SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA PLEDGES TO ENCOURAGE AND PARTICIPATE IN THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES OF MINNESOTA'S INDIAN PEOPLE; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HOLDS DEEP AND SINCERE RESPECT FOR THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE, THE MINNESOTA SIOUX TRIBE AND THE MINNESOTA INDIAN CONTRACTOR'S ASSOCIATION (MICA) FOR THEIR EFFORTS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS TOWARD INDIAN SELF-DETERMINATION; AND

WHEREAS: A WIDE RANGE OF INDIAN-OWNED ECONOMIC ENTERPRISES ARE AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE MANY VALUABLE GOODS AND SERVICES TO BOTH THE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTORS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 7 THROUGH 9, 1981 TO BE

INDIAN BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THESE DAYS WITH INCREASED AWARENESS OF COOPERATIVE EFFORTS AMONG INDIAN ENTERPRISES, MINNESOTA'S STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, AND OTHER MINNESOTA CORPORATIONS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
