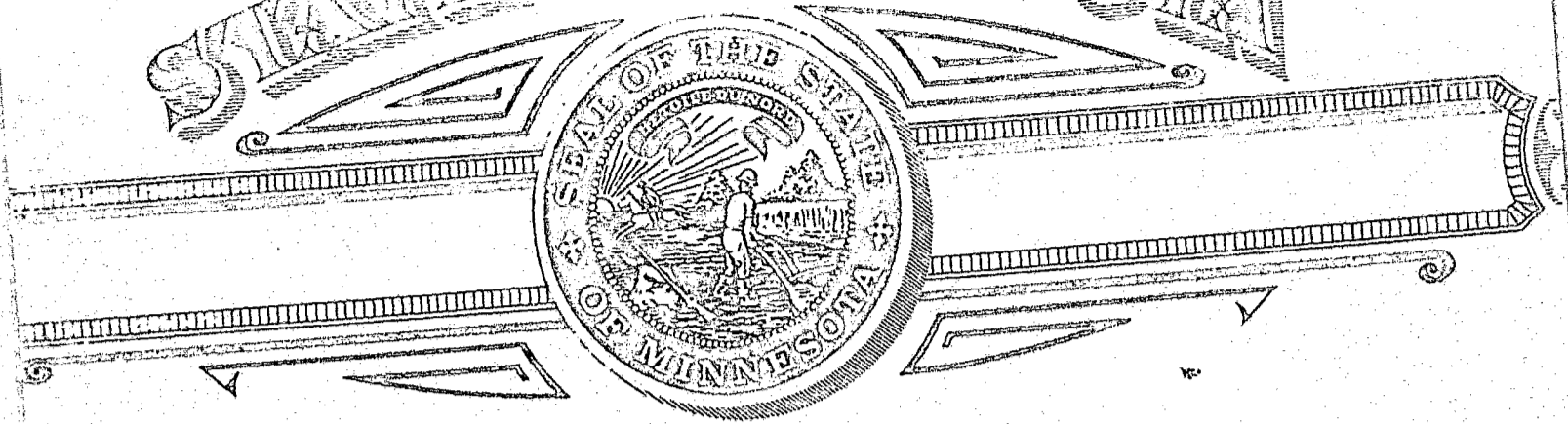


STATUTE OF MINNESOTA



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: MORE THAN 20,000 YOUNG PEOPLE IN MINNESOTA ARE NEWSPAPER CARRIERS;  
 AND  
 WHEREAS: THESE YOUNG PEOPLE SHOW EXTRAORDINARY AMBITION AND WILLINGNESS TO ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY; AND  
 WHEREAS: NEWSPAPER CARRIERS OPERATE AS INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS TO THE STATE'S NEWSPAPERS, THEREFORE LEARNING HOW TO OPERATE A SMALL BUSINESS, AS WELL AS HOW TO DEAL WITH PEOPLE; AND  
 WHEREAS: NEWSPAPER CARRIERS PROVIDE A SERVICE WHICH MAKES NEWS EASILY AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC; AND  
 WHEREAS: THIS EFFORT HELPS TO PROMOTE FREEDOM OF THE PRESS; AND  
 WHEREAS: EACH YEAR, A SPECIAL DAY IS SET ASIDE TO RECOGNIZE THE EFFORTS, INITIATIVE, CREATIVITY AND DEDICATION OF NEWSPAPER CARRIERS THROUGHOUT MINNESOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SATURDAY, OCTOBER 17, 1981 TO BE

## NEWSPAPER CARRIER DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE HIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO RECOGNIZE THIS SERVICE PROVIDED BY OUR YOUNG PEOPLE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER OF THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
