



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE 26TH ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE ASSOCIATION OF RECORDS MANAGERS AND ADMINISTRATORS, INC. (ARMA) IS TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF ST. PAUL, MINNESOTA FROM OCTOBER 4 THROUGH 7, 1981; AND

WHEREAS: ARMA IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION WHOSE PRIMARY OBJECTIVES ARE TO PROMOTE SCIENTIFIC INTEREST IN RECORDED INFORMATION MANAGEMENT; AND
