



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA ARE COMMITTED TO INSURING THE RIGHTS OF ALL PEOPLE TO EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES; AND

WHEREAS: AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PROGRAMS PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN ACHIEVING THIS GOAL OF EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA STATE AFFIRMATIVE ACTION ASSOCIATION WILL HOLD ITS ANNUAL AWARDS DINNER ON THE EVENING OF OCTOBER 15, 1981, WHERE THEY WILL HONOR INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE MADE OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GOALS OF AFFIRMATIVE ACTION;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 15, 1981 TO BE

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION DAY

AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS THIRTIETH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD,
