WHEREAS: Over half of the women age 16 and over are in the labor force.

WHEREAS: THE FEDERATION HAS KEPT IN STEP WITH THE ASPIRATIONS AND NEEDS OF WOMEN, AND EQUALLY IMPORTANT, IT HAS STRESSED ADVANCEMENT BASED ON DEMONSTRATED CAPACITY TO LEAD;
