



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL HAIRDRESSERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS ASSOCIATION HAVE, THROUGH THEIR TRAINING AND CREATIVE TALENTS, ENHANCED AND MAINTAINED THE APPEARANCE OF THE PEOPLE OF OUR NATION; AND

WHEREAS: THIS NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COSMETOLOGISTS WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1921 TO FURTHER THE HIGHEST STANDARDS OF PROFESSIONAL COSMETOLOGY CARE; AND

WHEREAS: THE 68,000 MEMBERS OF THIS ASSOCIATION WILL CELEBRATE NATIONAL COSMETOLOGY WEEK DURING THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 11 THROUGH 17, 1981; AND

WHEREAS: PROCEEDS FROM NATIONAL COSMETOLOGY WEEK ACTIVITIES ARE GIVEN TO LOCAL CHARITIES FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY; AND

WHEREAS: THE 1981 OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL COSMETOLOGY WEEK IS BEING HELD IN HONOR OF THE UNITED NATION'S DESIGNATION OF 1981 AS THE "INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF DISABLED PERSONS" AND IS EMBODYING THE THEME OF FOCUSING ATTENTION ON THE ENJOYMENT BY DISABLED PERSONS OF RIGHTS AND OPPORTUNITIES WHICH ENSURE THEIR FULL PARTICIPATION IN THEIR COMMUNITIES;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 11 THROUGH 17, 1981 TO BE

COSMETOLOGY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIFTH DAY OF OCTOBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
