



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MORE THAN HALF OF THE STUDENTS IN MOST HIGH SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE ARE INVOLVED IN AT LEAST ONE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY PROGRAM; AND

WHEREAS: THIS "OTHER HALF OF EDUCATION" PLAYS A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN THE TOTAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS; AND

WHEREAS: ACTIVITIES IN SPORTS, SPEECH, MUSIC, DEBATE, THEATRE AND OTHER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES, PROVIDE A CONSTRUCTIVE OUTLET FOR THE ENERGIES AND CREATIVE TALENTS OF YOUNG PEOPLE; AND

WHEREAS: EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES EXTEND OPPORTUNITIES FOR SOCIALIZATION AND INTERACTION AMONG HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS; AND

WHEREAS: HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES DIRECTLY BENEFIT LOCAL COMMUNITIES BY CHANNELING THE INTERESTS OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN A POSITIVE MANNER; AND

WHEREAS: HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES CONTRIBUTE TOWARD DEVELOPING WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUALS AND EXPANDING THE AWARENESS AND CAPABILITIES OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS BEYOND THE ACADEMIC WORLD;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 19 THROUGH 25, 1981 TO BE
