STATES AFFECTING MORE THAN ONE-HALF MILLION AMERICANS; AND

HEREAS: LUPUS CAN STRIKE MEN AND WOMEN AT ANY AGE, BUT 85% OF THE CASES OCCUR IN FEMALES BETWEEN THE AGES OF 10 AND 40; AND

*** REAS: LUPUS IS ALSO CALLED AUTOIMMUNE DISEASE IN WHICH THE PATIENT'S IMMUNE SYSTEM IS OUT OF CONTROL; AND

WHEREAS: WITH EARLY DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT, AN 85% SURVIVAL RATE IS NOT UNCOMMON; AND

WHEREAS: THE LUPUS FOUNDATION OF AMERICA AND OUR MINNESOTA CHAPTER, A NON PROFIT ORGANIZATION, WAS FORMED TO GAIN PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THIS BAFFLING DISEASE AND TO SUPPORT RESEARCH IN ORDER TO SEEK NEW METHODS OF CONTROL, PREVENTION AND, HOPEFULLY, TO FIND A CURE;

JW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 18 THROUGH 24, 1981 TO BE

LUPUS AWARENESS WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
