WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION OF MINNESOTA REPRESENTS A GROWING PROFESSION IN TODAY'S TOTAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAM; AND

WHEREAS: PHYSICAL THERAPISTS' PRIMARY MISSION IS THE PREVENTION AND REDUCTION OF PHYSICAL DISABILITY;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 18 THROUGH 24, 1981 TO BE
