WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM HAS SERVED OUR NATION ADMIRABLY FOR THIRTY-FIVE YEARS THROUGH ADVANCED PRACTICES AND NUTRITION EDUCATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM IS DEDICATED TO THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF OUR NATION'S SCHOOL CHILDREN; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM HAS BEEN JOINED THROUGH THE YEARS BY MANY OTHER EXCELLENT CHILD FEEDING PROGRAMS; AND

WHEREAS: THERE IS EVIDENCE OF CONTINUED NEED FOR NUTRITION EDUCATION AND AWARENESS OF THE VALUE OF SCHOOL FEEDING PROGRAMS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 11 THROUGH 17, 1981 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIFTH DAY OF OCTOBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD,
