

Section 14 - PENALTY. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by imprisonment in jail or the workhouse for no more than ninety (90) days or by fine not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or both.

Section 15 - PROVISIONS SEVERABLE. If any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Commission hereby declares it would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance if it had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional.

Section 16 - REPEALER. As of the effective date of this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 43 is hereby revoked.

Section 17 - EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance, upon filing the same with proof of publication thereof with the Secretary of State of Minnesota, shall be in full force and effect from and after 12:01 A.M. on November 1, 1981.
