WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS CONCERNED WITH THE EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF STUDENTS FOR PRODUCTIVE, SATISFYING CAREERS; AND

WHEREAS: MARKETING AND DISTRIBUTIVE EDUCATION STUDENTS OF THIS STATE ARE ENGAGED IN THE ESSENTIAL TASKS OF PROVIDING GOODS AND SERVICES TO THE CONSUMERS OF OUR COMMUNITIES; AND

WHEREAS: THE STUDENTS OF MARKETING AND DISTRIBUTIVE EDUCATION HAVE CHOSEN TO PURSUE CAREERS IN THE FIELDS OF MARKETING, DISTRIBUTION AND MANAGEMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE WELL-BEING OF OUR CITIZENS DEPENDS ON THE HEALTH OF OUR ECONOMY; AND

WHEREAS: THE PRINCIPLE OF FREEDOM OF ENTERPRISE IS THE BASIS OF OUR ECONOMY AND PROVIDES THE CHIEF IMPETUS FOR ITS GROWTH AND STABILITY;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 8 THROUGH 12, 1982 TO BE
