Members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries adhere WHEREAS: TO A STRICT CODE OF ETHICS, MAINTAINING THE HIGHEST STANDARDS IN THEIR CONTACTS WITH GOVERNMENT, COURTS, LAW OFFICES, CLIENTS AND ALL PERSONS; AND

WHEREAS: THE EFFICIENCY OF THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF LEGAL SECRETARIES IS OF FIRST IMPORTANCE TO GOVERNMENT, THE COURTS, AND TO ATTORNEYS AND THEIR CLIENTS; AND

ONE OF THE AIMS AND PURPOSES OF THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF LEGAL WHEREAS: SECRETARIES IS TO FURTHER THE EDUCATION OF ITS MEMBERS AND TO INCREASE THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF THE LAW; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST THAT LEGAL SECRETARIES HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO OBSERVE THE GOVERNMENT WITH WHICH THEY ARE SO CLOSELY ASSOCIATED;
