



Proclamation

HEREAS: THE MINNESOTA JAYCEE WOMEN HAVE PROMOTED COMMUNITY SERVICE IN MINNESOTA FOR 32 YEARS; AND

HEREAS: THE MINNESOTA JAYCEE WOMEN IS AN ORGANIZATION OF OVER 5,000 YOUNG WOMEN OF TODAY IN OVER 275 COMMUNITIES; AND

HEREAS: THE MINNESOTA JAYCEE WOMEN SHALL SET ASIDE THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 7 THROUGH 13, 1982 TO EDUCATE THE COMMUNITY IN THE AREAS OF ON-GOING PROJECTS IN ACCENT ON YOUTH, AID TO RETARDED CITIZENS, COMMUNITY SERVICE, MEDICAL HEALTH, PREVENT CHILD ABUSE, REYE'S SYNDROME, AND TODAY'S WOMAN; AND

HEREAS: THE MINNESOTA JAYCEE WOMEN PROVIDE INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT TO TOMORROW'S LEADERS; AND

HEREAS: THEIR CREED STATES, "MAY WE LEAVE THE WORLD A BETTER PLACE BECAUSE WE LIVED AND SERVED WITHIN IT";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 7 THROUGH 13, 1982 TO BE

JAYCEE WOMEN WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF OCTOBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
