

## **Proclamation**

HEREAS: Two hundred and six years ago, on November 10, 1775, the Continental CONGRESS RESOLVED THAT A CORPS OF MARINES BE RAISED TO SERVE, AND THAT THEY BE DISTINGUISHED BY THE NAME OF AMERICAN MARINES; AND

MARINES HAVE LONG ACQUITTED THEMSELVES WITH DISTINCTION AND HONOR HEREAS: IN WAR AND PEACE AS DEFENDERS OF FREEDOM THE WORLD OVER; AND

THE SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF MINNESOTA, PAST AND PRESENT, HAVE HEREAS: CONTRIBUTED SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE PROUD RECORD OF THE CORPS; AND

IT IS FITTING AND APPROPRIATE THAT WE RECOGNIZE AND REMEMBER THE HEREAS: TWO HUNDRED SIXTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF THE MARINE CORPS;

OW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 6 THROUGH 13, 1981 TO BE

N WITNESS WHEREOF. WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT EAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF OCTOBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE TATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
