WHEREAS: THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA BANDS ANNUALLY ACCEPT NEW MEMBERS;
AND

WHEREAS: THIS YEAR NEW BAND MEMBERS WILL BE INITIATED DURING THE WEEK OF
OCTOBER 5 THROUGH 9, 1981; AND

WHEREAS: DURING THIS WEEK, NEW MEMBERS ARE KNOWN AS "STOOGES" AND ARE SUBJECTED
TO THE ORDERS OF VETERAN BAND MEMBERS KNOWN AS "STOOGEMASTERS"; AND

WHEREAS: THIS INITIATION PERIOD KNOWN AS "STOUGE WEEK" COMES TO A CLOSE
ON OCTOBER 9;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA,
DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 5 THROUGH 9, 1981 TO BE

STOUGE WEEK

AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION
FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FIFTH DAY OF OCTOBER IN
THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE
THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
