HEREAS: PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS PROVIDE LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES IN A VARIETY OF SUBJECT AREAS, BUILDING FROM THE FOUNDATION OF EACH CHILD'S BASIC READING AND MATH SKILLS; AND

HEREAS: Some CHILDREN REQUIRE SPECIAL ASSISTANCE TO PROPERLY DEVELOP THESE CRITICAL MATH AND READING ABILITIES: AND

HEREAS: TITLE I OF THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY ACT PROVIDES PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL CHILDREN WITH ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS AND PERSONNEL TO ASSIST THESE STUDENTS PERFORMING BELOW GRADE LEVEL IN READING AND MATH; AND
