



Proclamation

WHEREAS: IT IS DESIRABLE THAT THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA RECOGNIZE THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF OUR YOUTH AND THE POSITIVE CONTRIBUTIONS THEY ARE MAKING TOWARD THE BETTERMENT OF MANKIND; AND

WHEREAS: ENCOURAGING A GREATER INTERCHANGE OF IDEAS BETWEEN ADULTS AND YOUTH WILL LEAD TO A BROADER UNDERSTANDING OF EACH OTHER'S PROBLEMS; AND

WHEREAS: THE "YOUTH APPRECIATION WEEK" PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY OPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL IN 1957 ENCOURAGES PARENTS TO REDEDICATE THEMSELVES TO THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARENTHOOD AND RECOGNIZES THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF YOUTH IN THE HOME, SCHOOL, CHURCH AND COMMUNITY; AND

WHEREAS: THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA WISH TO JOIN WITH THE OPTIMISTS IN EXPRESSING THEIR APPRECIATION FOR AND APPROVAL OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF OUR YOUTH;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 8 THROUGH 14, 1981 TO BE

YOUTH APPRECIATION WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF OCTOBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
