WHEREAS: THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY IN MINNESOTA IS A SIGNIFICANT EMPLOYER OF MINNESOTA RESIDENTS. IS A TAXPAYER PROVIDING THE STATE FUNDS. IS AN EXPORTER OF INSURANCE SERVICES TO OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY AND THE WORLD: AND

WHEREAS: THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY IN MINNESOTA IS A POWERFUL AND DYNAMIC FORCE AFFECTING THE ECONOMY OF MINNESOTA AND THE NATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY IN MINNESOTA HAS PROVIDED A HIGH DEGREE OF PROFESSIONALISM AMONG ITS MANY AGENTS AND INSURANCE COMPANY PERSONNEL THROUGH EDUCATION AND PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, ONE OF WHICH IS THE MINNESOTA CHAPTER OF CHARTERED PROPERTY AND CASUALTY UNDERWRITERS; AND
