



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MANUFACTURERS' REPRESENTATIVES SELL OVER 70% OF RETAIL FOOD PRODUCTS CONSUMED BY MINNESOTANS; AND

WHEREAS: THE ASSOCIATION OF MANUFACTURERS' REPRESENTATIVES IMPROVES THE CONDITIONS SURROUNDING THE SELLING OF THESE FOOD PRODUCTS; AND

WHEREAS: THE ASSOCIATION OF MANUFACTURERS' REPRESENTATIVES PROMOTES EFFICIENT AND CONSTRUCTIVE SALESMANSHIP BY ENCOURAGING LEGITIMATE, FAIR AND ETHICAL BUSINESS CONDUCT AND PRACTICES; AND

WHEREAS: THE ASSOCIATION OF MANUFACTURERS' REPRESENTATIVES FOSTERS AND PROMOTES FEELINGS OF GOODWILL AND FELLOWSHIP BETWEEN ITS MEMBERS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 1981 TO BE

MANUFACTURERS' REPRESENTATIVES DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS THIRD DAY OF NOVEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
