WHEREAS: THE PURPOSE OF GOVERNMENT IS TO PROVIDE FOR THE GENERAL HEALTH AND WELFARE OF ITS CITIZENS; AND

WHEREAS: Government can best meet the needs of the people when it responds to citizens' requests for services in a fair and just manner; and

WHEREAS: OMBUDSMEN (MEN AND WOMEN) ARE PUBLIC OFFICIALS DEDICATED TO HELPING CITIZENS GAIN ACCESS TO GOVERNMENT SERVICES IN A FAIR AND JUST MANNER; AND

WHEREAS: THE U.S. ASSOCIATION OF OMBUDSMEN IS AN ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO FOSTERING THE OMBUDSMAN CONCEPT AND MOVEMENT IN GOVERNMENT THROUGHOUT THIS COUNTRY; AND

WHEREAS: THE U.S. Association of Ombudsman is holding its Fifth Annual Meeting in the City of Minneapolis, State of Minnesota, November 5-7, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM NOVEMBER 5 THROUGH 7, 1981 TO BE

OMBUDSMEN DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
