

Proclamation

WHEREAS: COURAGE CENTER PROGRAMS ARE SERVING MORE THAN 15,000 PEOPLE WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES IN THE UPPER MIDWEST; AND

- WHEREAS: HANDICAPPED SKI TEAMS ARE PART OF THE COURAGE CENTER PROGRAMS WHICH PROMOTE THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND ASPIRATIONS OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES; AND
- WHEREAS: SPIRIT MOUNTAIN IN THE CITY OF DULUTH WILL HOST THE 1982 MIDWEST HANDICAPPED SKI RACES WITH DISABLED SKIERS FROM MINNESOTA, NORTH DAKOTA, SOUTH DAKOTA, MICHIGAN, INDIANA, KENTUCKY, MISSOURI, ILLINOIS, OHIO, IOWA AND WISCONSIN BEING INVITED TO PARTICIPATE; AND

WHEREAS: THE 1982 MIDWEST HANDICAPPED SKI RACES WILL BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 4-6, 1982 WITH COMPETITORS SEEKING TO QUALIFY IN THIS REGIONAL MEET IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NATIONAL HANDICAPPED SKI CHAMPIONSHIPS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 1 THROUGH FEBRUARY 7, 1982, TO BE

HANDICAPPED SKIERS WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I urge the citizens of the State of Minnesota to support our Minnesota disabled skiers in their quest to reach the National Handicapped Ski Championships.
