

At the time the above ordinance was adopted (1974) the law stated the annexation was final upon filing the ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Minnesota Municipal Board, County Auditor and affected township.



ORDINANCE NO. 198

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LONG PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition, dated August 19, 1974, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on August 19, 1974, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced with the area described in the petition and bounded as described is less than two hundred (200) acres of unplatted land, being approximately 37 acres, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the owner of said property, and

WHEREAS, no objection to the annexation has been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the township board and other persons were properly notified of the annexation and more than 60 days have elapsed since notification and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the north boundary thereof:

The Council of the City of Long Prairie, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines:

- (a) That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City, and of the territory affected.
- (b) That the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is urban or suburban in character.
- (c) That none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.


Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof and is zoned as provided herein:

Parcel One: $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Twp. 129, R. 33, except as follows. to-wit: Commencing at a point on the easterly right of way line of the Great Northern Railroad and 60 ft. S. of the E. and W. Quarter line running through said Section 8-129-33 and lying in the $N\frac{1}{2}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 8, and to take this point as the point of beginning; thence easterly and parallel with the said east and west $\frac{1}{4}$ line 200 ft., thence S. 243.9 ft. to the northwesterly right of way line of the Great Northern Railroad spur track serving the Central Bi-Products Plant, thence southwesterly along the said northwesterly right of way line intersects the easterly right of way line of the Great Northern Railroad track, thence northerly along the said easterly right of way line 507 ft. more or less, to the point of beginning.


Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
