The Council received the Summary Statement of Votes prepared by the Election Judges. The Summary Statement of Votes cast and counted on the question; " Currently the city operates and intends to continue to operate a municipal liquor store. Shall the city of Olivia in addition be authorized to issue private 'on-sale' licenses to hotels and restaurants as defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.07?"

No.....148

WHEREUPON, a motion was made by J. Stumpf, seconded by H. Reidel that the Council accept the Summary Statement of Votes as presented by the Election Judges and the issue be declared passed. Motion carried unanimously.
