



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE BIENNIAL BUDGET FOR THE STATE OF MINNESOTA FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING ON JUNE 30, 1983 HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE LEGISLATURE AND SIGNED INTO LAW;  
AND

WHEREAS: BECAUSE OF THE CONTINUING RECESSIONARY TRENDS IN THE NATIONAL ECONOMY, REVENUES TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA DURING THE CURRENT BIENNIUM ARE NOW PROJECTED TO BE SIGNIFICANTLY LOWER THAN ANTICIPATED AT THE TIME THE BUDGET WAS ADOPTED, THUS CREATING FISCAL PROBLEMS OF A MAGNITUDE UNPRECEDENTED IN THE STATE'S HISTORY; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS NECESSARY TO IMMEDIATELY ADDRESS THE STATE'S CURRENT CASH-FLOW PROBLEM PRIOR TO THE NEXT REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE, THEREBY CREATING AN EXTRAORDINARY OCCASION; AND

WHEREAS: ARTICLE IV, SECTION 12 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA

PROVIDES THAT A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE MAY BE CALLED ON  
EXTRAORDINARY OCCASIONS;

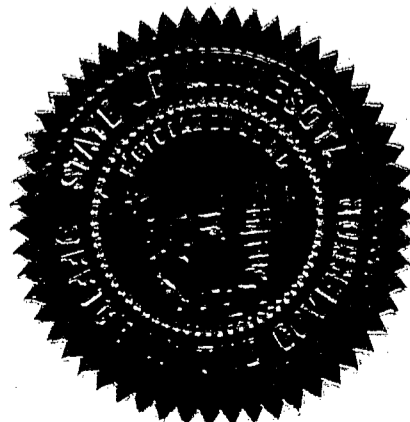
NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY  
SUMMON YOU, MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE, TO CONVENE IN SPECIAL SESSION ON TUESDAY,  
DECEMBER 1, 1981 AT 2:00 P.M. IN THE AFTERNOON AT THE CAPITOL IN SAINT PAUL.

I URGE THE LEGISLATURE TO IMMEDIATELY ADDRESS THE NEED TO ASSURE THAT STATE  
GOVERNMENT HAS SUFFICIENT MONIES AVAILABLE TO MEET ITS CASH-FLOW NEEDS, AS WELL  
AS SUCH OTHER MATTERS WHICH MUST BE ADDRESSED PRIOR TO THE NEXT REGULAR SESSION  
OF THE LEGISLATURE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I HAVE HEREUNTO SET MY HAND AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE  
STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS NINETEENTH DAY OF NOVEMBER IN THE YEAR OF  
OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED  
TWENTY-THIRD.
