



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA'S AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY IS AN IMPORTANT SOURCE OF A WIDE VARIETY OF HIGH QUALITY FOODS; AND

WHEREAS: APPROXIMATELY 35 MILLION DOLLARS OF FOOD PRODUCTS ARE PURCHASED LOCALLY BY MINNESOTA SCHOOLS; AND

WHEREAS: THERE ARE 2,010 SCHOOLS PARTICIPATING IN THE SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM IN MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: 400,000 SCHOOL CHILDREN DERIVE ONE THIRD OF THEIR DAILY NUTRITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FROM THIS PROGRAM; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS FITTING WE SALUTE OUR YOUTH, OUR SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM AND OUR AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY;

AND THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JANUARY 11, 1982 TO BE

ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL
MINNESOTA SCHOOLS

MINNESOTA AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE TO PARTICIPATE IN SERVING FOODS PRODUCED AND PROCESSED IN MINNESOTA.

WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS FOURTEENTH DAY OF DECEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
