EREAS: MINNESOTA'S AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY IS AN IMPORTANT SOURCE OF A WIDE VARIETY OF HIGH QUALITY FOODS; AND

EREAS: Approximately 35 million dollars of food products are purchased locally by Minnesota schools; and

EREAS: THERE ARE 2,010 SCHOOLS PARTICIPATING IN THE SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM IN MINNESOTA: AND

EREAS: 400,000 school children derive one third of their daily nutritional requirements from this program; and

EREAS: It is fitting we salute our youth, our School Lunch Program and our agricultural industry;

HEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF JANUARY 11, 1982 TO BE
