WHEREAS: EACH YEAR THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES PROCLAIMS JANUARY AS NATIONAL HOBBY MONTH; AND

WHEREAS: INVOLVEMENT IN CONSTRUCTIVE HOBBIES CONTRIBUTES IMMEASUREABLY TO THE GENERAL VITALITY AND WELL BEING OF OUR NATION AND TO THE PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH OF ITS PEOPLE; AND

WHEREAS: HOBBIES BRING TO ALL A SENSE OF INDIVIDUAL ACHIEVEMENT AND PURPOSE AND A FEELING OF SELF-FULFILLMENT; AND

WHEREAS: HOBBIES MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR FAMILIES TO WORK TOGETHER ON LEISURE TIME PROJECTS AND TO SHARE IN REWARDING EXPERIENCES; AND

WHEREAS: HOBBIES PROVIDE MEANINGFUL INTERACTION BETWEEN PEOPLE OF ALL AGES, WHILE OFFERING THEM AN OPPORTUNITY FOR SELF-EXPRESSION; AND

WHEREAS: HOBBIES ARE FUN; AND

WHEREAS: WE ARE A NATION THAT HAS THRIVED ON THE INVENTIVENESS, INGENUITY AND PERSEVERANCE OF ITS HARD WORKING CITIZENS, THIS NATIONAL OBSERVANCE PERPETUATES A TRADITION IN WHICH WE CAN ALL TAKE PRIDE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 1982 TO BE
