WHEREAS: THE FOUNDATION OF AMERICA'S GREATNESS IS THE STRENGTH OF ITS FAMILIES: AND

WHEREAS: THE FAMILY IS ESTABLISHED ON THE MARRIAGE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FATHER AND MOTHER; AND

WHEREAS: There is an urgent need to reverse the present trend of separation and divorce that is sweeping the country; and

WHEREAS: Marriage should be viewed as a life-long commitment between husband and wife, filled with mutual respect and open communications; and

WHEREAS: IT IS OUR HOPE THAT THE INSTITUTION OF MARRIAGE ONCE AGAIN BE RECOGNIZED AS THE BASIS OF AMERICAN SOCIETY:

NOW. THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE. GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM FEBRUARY 14, 1982, VALENTINE'S DAY, TO BE
