CHAPTER 490.



WHEREAS, the said James T. Knutson has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Section 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement on December 31, 1981.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable James T. Knutson, Judge of the Probate-County Court, County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be made effective on December 31, 1981. He shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490. I hereby direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.


