WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAS BEEN MOST PROGRESSIVE IN ITS IDEAS ABOUT AND ACTION TOWARD PEOPLE WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES; AND

WHEREAS: PARTICIPATION IN SPORTS LEADS TO A BETTER QUALITY OF LIFE FOR OUR CITIZENS; AND

WHEREAS: THE COURAGE CENTER IS HOSTING THE 34TH NATIONAL WHEELCHAIR BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT; AND

WHEREAS: THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE GOAL IS TO FOCUS ATTENTION ON OTHER ABILITIES IN ADDITION TO BASKETBALL TALENTS; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS APPROPRIATE TO SET ASIDE THESE DAYS IN RECOGNITION OF THE ATHLETIC ABILITIES AND DEDICATION OF THE PARTICIPANTS;
